AFTER SCHOOL PIANO LESSONS IN UPPER HUTT

Professional classical musician Amber Rainey, has most recently worked as the deputy pianist for West Side Story at the Wellington Opera House. In New Zealand Amber has also worked as a pianist with the New Zealand Symphony Orchestra, Chamber Music New Zealand and New Zealand Opera – in 2018 on shows with Sole Mio's Pene Pati. She has been a member of teaching staff at Victoria University's New Zealand School of Music in the vocal department, and her degrees include a Master of Music from the Guildhall School of Music & Drama, London. Amber was an Emerging Artist at London's National Opera Studio, working in collaboration with the 6 UK opera houses, and coaches including Kiri Te Kanawa.

LESSONS: Amber, 32 has loads of experience teaching piano and theory, including working in primary and secondary schools in London. She has taken young students through for university entrance, all examination levels and junior and secondary school music scholarships.

After school care information for parents

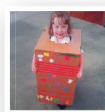
At after School care we offer the children activities that are designed to explore creativity promote fitness and to encourage the children to learn something new.

At the start of everyday we have mat time to discuss the days plan.

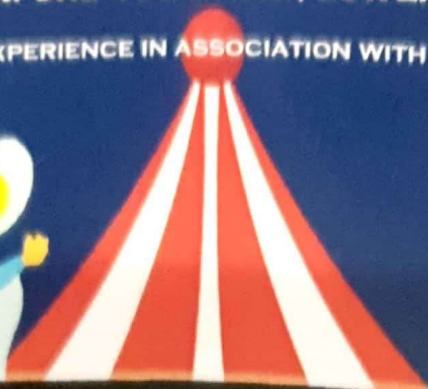
