# FOOD ALLERGY AWARENESS WEEK 12-18 MAY

**Fact: Food allergy affects 1 in 10 children under five\***

**But did you know it is rare for a child to develop an allergy to a food they have previously eaten without problems?**

### What's the difference between a food allergy and a food intolerance?

- ♥ **A food allergy** is an exaggerated response by the immune system to a food protein. **Reactions** usually happen **within minutes** of eating a food that contains the allergen. **Symptoms** can include hives, itching, swelling, vomiting, abdominal pain, diarrhoea and nausea, and in some cases anaphylaxis (life-threatening).
- ♥ **A food intolerance** is an adverse reaction to certain foods, not involving the immune system. **Reactions** can be immediate or happen up to **20 hours** after a food is eaten. **Symptoms** can include (but are not limited to) bloating, wind, diarrhoea, nausea and indigestion.

**If you think your child has a food allergy or intolerance see a doctor.**

## EXPRESSIONS WHIRINAKI ARTS & ENTERTAINMENT CENTRE

Expressions Whirinaki Arts & Entertainment Centre is Upper Hutt's own art hub. We are committed to offering engaging and accessible visual and performing art experiences for local students and have a range of exciting and world class programmes.

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Expressions Whirinaki Arts & Entertainment Centre presents a vibrant and diverse exhibition programme throughout the year including artworks and exhibitions of national significance as well as those representing artists from the wider Wellington Region and our own Upper Hutt community.

With an ever changing exhibition programme and most exhibitions suitable for children, schools can visit on a regular basis. During an educational visit students will learn to look closely and think critically to develop a greater understanding of art, culture and history.

Educational visits are ALWAYS FREE. They are tailored to suit the age of the students and usually involve a tour and discussion about the exhibition and an associated hands-on art or craft activity. They are presented by an experienced art facilitator and they can run from an hour to one and a half hours.

### TUIA 250

In 2019, New Zealand will mark 250 years since the first meetings between Māori and Europeans during James Cook and the Endeavour's 1769 voyage to Aotearoa New Zealand. A national commemoration Tuia - Encounters will acknowledge this pivotal moment in our nation's history, as well as the exceptional feats of Pacific Voyagers who reached and settled in Aotearoa many years earlier.

Our 2019 programme will endorse these commemorations through our programme, weaving relevant content on the first meetings between early settlers and local Māori into our vision of the shared future of Aotearoa.



### AEIOU: TUHURAHIA TE ARAPU MAORI EXPLORE THE MAORI ALPHABET

4 May to 30 June

AEIOU is a child focused exhibition, all about the Māori alphabet. Do your kids enjoy singing waiata (songs)? Do you know the Māori word for horse? Have you ever tried to twirl a poi? Have fun exploring them all, and lots more interactive activities, in a new exhibition AEIOU: Tūhuria te arapū Māori | Explore the Māori alphabet.

From Aotearoa (New Zealand) to whare (house), ngata (snail) to hoiho (horse) visitors will have fun learning new Māori words through a diverse mix of items, to help you celebrate matariki.

AEIOU is a celebration of our national language that is unique and special to Aotearoa.

#### Curriculum links

AEIOU will link to the social sciences curriculum, helping students to understand how the past is important to people, and how places in New Zealand are important for individuals and groups. It also links to the visual arts curriculum with the objective of enabling students to understand the visual arts in context. AEIOU will also link to communication and interpreting, where students will be given the opportunity and the tools to critically evaluate, reflect and respond to artworks.
