Parent Responsibility Agreement - Smart Streamers

- If I have questions or concerns about the way in which technology is being used by my child at school, I know the school is happy to discuss this with me, and I am aware that I am welcome to do this at any time.
- I have read and understand the principles and guidelines for 'Smart Streamers' that 'T.H.I.N.K' and understand that my child will be responsible for adhering to these principles and guidelines.
- I understand that if my child fails to adhere to the rules set out within the Student User Agreement, the Smart Streamers guidelines, or fails to T.H.I.N.K, appropriate consequences will be determined, in consultation with me.
- Devices will only be used under adult supervision whilst at school, as part of the learning programme.
- Rules governing the use of any school-owned/ student owned digital device will apply to all students while they are at school. This includes adherence to the Copyright Act and school IT policies and guidelines.
- The school technicians along with responsible school staff will monitor the programmes/applications used on devices children have used at school.
- The school technicians along with responsible school staff may periodically inspect and monitor devices children use to check for appropriate usage, including accessing browser history and/or caches as well as all files on devices.
- I have read the student responsibility agreement and the Smart Streamers document and have talked with my child about what it means to them. I am happy that my child understands what this means, and that they are capable of working within the guidelines.
- The school adheres to a 'sharing screen' concept, whereby my child may share his/her screen with others. In collaborative group work there may be 2-3 children working together.
- Children will use cloud based applications such as Google for Education for file management and are encouraged to access this at home with parent permission.

- I understand that our school has a policy and associated procedures/ guidelines * which outlines the schools digital citizenship approach and how this supports teaching and learning. **These documents are available on the school website.*
- I understand that the school provides monitored and filtered access to the internet and other communications technologies.
- I understand that the school encourages responsible behaviour by students when using technology to help protect themselves and each other from experiencing harm online. I am aware that this 'Student User Agreement' and 'Smart Streamers' guidelines is part of that, and that it encourages students to consider how their actions can affect themselves and those around them.
- I am aware that students can experience challenges when using technology, but that the school makes every effort to support students to manage those challenges effectively. I understand that by learning to deal with them in a safe environment with the appropriate support they will be better prepared to deal with those challenges in the future.
- The school is aware of the associated health risks due to extended use of screens or digital devices. The school will monitor and limit student use of devices, ensuring adequate breaks, seating and lighting to help minimise associated risks.
