Parking around the school

I do acknowledge parking around the school can be very challenging at times. We have a couple of problem areas at the moment which we would appreciate your help with.

Gard Street bus stop

Please don't obstruct or park in the bus stop on Gard Street, it is likely you will be ticketed if you are parked or stopped in the bus space, even if only for a few seconds.

Disability Parking on Whitemans Road

This can be confusing.

- There is a disability park next to the crossing on Whitemans Road which can be used at any time for those with disability stickers.
- There are two disability parks onsite at school although these cannot be accessed between 8.20 am – 9.00 am and 2.45 pm- 3.15 pm as we only have one access road for both children and cars into the site. At all other times it can be used for people with disability stickers visiting the school.
- There is a double disability space next to the bus stop on Whitemans Road. This is for rear loading vehicles only. Even if you have a disability sticker and park in that space you could be ticketed unless your vehicle is specifically a rear loading disability vehicle/bus. The purpose of the space is predominantly to ensure that one of our students, who is in a motorised wheelchair, can be rear loaded into her transport bus. It requires BOTH the spaces for her to be safely transported. If someone parks in one of the spaces, she has to wait until your car has moved to be able to get into her vehicle. On occasions she has had to wait up to 15 minutes.


Their fabulous Choir Coaches Joanne Roelof and Karen Boyce are also pictured with them. Well done **Gemma** and **Grayson**!






