Silverstream Trappers update

The Silverstream School trappers have been busy helping to protect our native species in the local area. We are an Enviroschool, and Pest Free 2050 is an important aspect of our school vision for our environment. This week they hit a magic number of 150 pests. They now have two traplines in the bush and 30 traps out in the community. They are adding about 5 new traps per week to make it sustainable for the staff and students to manage.

So far they have eliminated in the community:

Rats: 68Mice: 70Hedgehogs: 5Mustelids: 1Other: 6

Catch of the week was a 48cm, 500 gram rat caught by the Robinson family.






