ERO Celebration of Success

We are very, very pleased by the recent visit from the Education Review Office to Silverstream School and enjoyed spending time with the reviewer on site. Huge congratulations to all the Silverstream Staff and community who have contributed to such a positive and affirming report. We are heading in a good direction and have great support from the BoT and you as parents, you send us amazing students every day, thank you. The ongoing successes of the school are also affirming the changes we have made over the last 2 years. The school is in a great place and ready for our 2024 centenary year.

Te Ara Huarau is the evaluation approach that the Education Review Office (ERO) is using in schools. This a developmental approach to evaluation where ERO and schools work together over time rather than one off reviews that happened previously.

Our school worked alongside ERO to write our Profile Report. This type of report will only happen once as part of our initial engagement with Te Ara Huarau. The profile report reflects our strategic goals and a shared evaluation focus on one or more areas that are important to us as we work together to improve outcomes for all our learners.

ERO, like us, have a strong focus on equity and excellence. Future reporting will show our progress and achievement towards meeting the goals we have set ourselves. Unlike in previous years the current approach from ERO does not allow for 4–5-year reports anymore. Schools who are performing well receive a 3-year review, those requiring additional support may have a revisit earlier than 3 years. The reports are also very much shorter and in less detail than in the previous system.
