The Silverstream School Trappers Pest Free project

The Silverstream Trappers group of 20 Year 5 students have been hard at work. Due to the generosity of our parents at the recent Silverstream School Quiz, we have received the first batch of traps, consisting of 15 boxed rat traps. We have another 35 still to come, as well as 30 Good Nature traps. Our school is now connected with Pestfree Silverstream (but we are our own separate project), and we are getting our own trapline to monitor and clear near Sylvan Way. Our goals are to increase our local native bird, lizard and weta numbers, educate our students in biodiversity and get kiwi into the Silverstream School area.

Our total trap recordings to date as a project are as follows:

Grounds Development

As part of the grounds upgrading over the 2023/24 year, we have lots of exciting projects including new native tree plantings around the school, a dedicated and beautifully designed ANZAC area around the flagpole, new lighting, new planter boxes, new monkey bars, a new welcome mural, centenary commemorative plaques and a beautiful new school sign at the corner of Gard and Whitemans Road.

We do however have to look at replacing the large conifers which are at the corner of the school. They are very large, restricting the light into the classroom and the grass underneath is struggling. One of them has already split into 2 growing points and will split and fall within the next 5 years. We would like to make that corner of the school very special with new native trees and plantings, beautiful up-lighting and a brand-new school sign.


