What a team! We are very excited to have attracted such outstanding teachers to the team and are looking forward to what 2024 will bring and for what Silverstream School students can achieve.

Sabbaticals in 2024

Two staff members have been awarded academic sabbaticals in 2024.

Erin Edmonds has been awarded the Royal Society of Science Teaching Sabbatical in Terms 1 and 2 next year. Erin will be working on science and environmental projects out in the field and will bring back a greater expertise for science in the Primary sector from Term 3 onwards. Briana Rudduck will be taking over science in Term 1 before she leaves us to move to a teaching position in Melbourne, Australia.

I have been awarded the Teachers NZ Principals Sabbatical for Terms 1 and 2 next year. During my terms away I am looking into the Science of Learning from a neuroscience view and also more specifically the Science of Reading and Mathematics. I will be able to bring back to the school a deeper understanding of how young children acquire literacy and mathematical knowledge and therefore what schools need to be doing to ensure the most effective methods of teaching. Corey White will take over as Acting Principal for Terms 1 and 2.

2024 class visits

Children will be visiting their 2024 teachers on the morning of Friday 15th December. Class placement notices will be sent home with your child on the last day of term, Friday 15th December. If your child is not at school that day, they will be posted out to you. Many thanks.

End of year Progress and Achievement data (PaCT)

We will be sending this home with your child on Wednesday next week. This is the final academic and progress report for the 2023 year. The reports show the progress made in reading, writing and mathematics and each of the aspects of those subjects. It is very important to be aware that not all of the signposts (big concepts in the subject represented by a blue dot) will have moved over the last 6 months.

In most cases just one of the signposts will have changed. This is because it is a long journey between each of the signposts, for example Geometric Thinking in mathematics has only 6 significant signposts over 10 years of schooling. One geometry signpost will have nearly 2 years worth of content within it.

Your child's personalised education plan (PEP) which you updated with the teacher in week 2 of this term shows other data for the year in terms of engagement, attendance, values and competencies and other non-core subject areas.

I cannot convey in words how much I have appreciated working with Anthony and how much he does in the background for the school to make it as successful as it is. He has been a pleasure to work with and we will certainly miss his guidance and calm approach to what is a very multidimensional and complex role. The Board meet in late January to elect a new BoT chair for the 2024 year. Anthony will remain in place until the changeover on 31st January. Thank you Anthony, you will be greatly missed by the community and the team.


