

Things I Need

Day One

Your child will be part of Ako Iti (Little Learners) team. This includes children from New Entrants to Year 3.

Although we don't have a uniform, school polo shirts, hats and house T-shirts can be purchased from the office. Wide brimmed hats are compulsory to wear in Terms 1 and 4.

New Entrant Stationery Packs can be obtained from the school office. Please give all stationery to the classroom teacher on your last school visit.

We recommend that your child's school bag includes a named lunch box, drink bottle and a change of clothes. They will also need to bring their 'Take Home Pack' daily.



The first day of school is a very special day.

We suggest that you arrive between 8:30 and 8:50am. This will give your child time to do their morning jobs and set up for the day.

We encourage you to say goodbye to your child by 9:00am. We will contact you if your child becomes unsettled.
